Prepare for a career as an expert and leader in the international media field.

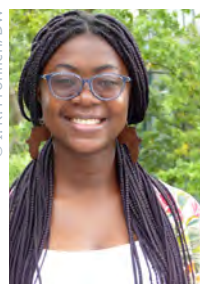

International Media Studies is an interdisciplinary and intercultural four-semester M.A. program combining topics such as media and development, journalism, communication science and media management. The degree offers an unparalleled mix of research, lectures and practical experience, and prepares students for careers in the communications and media industries. As a joint project of the University of Bonn, the Bonn-Rhein-Sieg University of Applied Sciences and Deutsche Welle (DW), the program admits up to 30 students in the fall semester every year.

Eligible applicants must have a Bachelor's degree or equivalent from a recognized academic institution, C1 level English proficiency and at least one year of professional experience in a media-related field after completing their undergraduate studies. The program is taught in English. The tuition fee is 6,000 euros.

SCHOLARSHIP

The German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) offers up to 10 scholarships for highly qualified applicants from developing and emerging economies each year. Scholarship applicants must have at least two years of work experience in a media related field.

Scholarship recipients will complete the fourth semester including the Master's thesis and colloquium in their home country.
